Slavka Eley joined the European Labour Authority in September 2021 taking charge of the Governance and Coordination Unit, covering a range of horizontal and corporate issues such as development of strategy and work programme, governing bodies operation, external relations, horizontal policy coordination of ELA operational activities, internal governance, and communication and EU wide information campaigns. She led the preparation of ELA's 2022 Framework for Actions in Road Transport and overseen its implementation. She established ELA's social partners liaison function and oversees ELA's Brussels liaison office.

Prior to joining ELA, she worked in the financial regulation and supervision. She joined the European Banking Authority (EBA) in 2013 and held various management positions involving the work on financial innovation, digital finance, capital market union and sustainable finance. She led development of a common EU supervisory framework for banking supervisors, work on supervisory cooperation and convergence. Before EBA, she worked for over a decade at National Bank of Slovakia where she held several management positions in banking supervision and policy development.

She holds a MBA in general management from the City University of Seattle and a Master degree in Mathematics and Physics from the Comenius University Bratislava.
