Jacek Saldan is the Head of Resources Unit at the European Labour Authority (ELA) since October 2020.

He has a degree in Electronics from Warsaw University of Technology and an Executive MBA from University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign. He is from Warsaw, Poland.

He worked as a manager in ICT services for multinational clients until 2008. He set up and executed various large outsourcing contracts, creating new delivery teams across different locations.

He joined EU institutions in 2008: Europol and

ELA. He managed ICT Operations and Facilities at Europol, ensuring smooth and secure service delivery to the EU law enforcement community and partners. His main challenge was moving Europol to its new building without disrupting or compromising any services. After the successful move, he oversaw the expansion of Europol data processing, the establishment of a top-notch disaster recovery site, and the first Europe-wide network for exchanging EU-confidential information.

From 2015, he was the Head of ICT Solutions Delivery, leading several projects that transformed the data processing at Europol according to the new regulation. These projects sparked an innovation programme that used modern technologies like machine learning to handle data processing challenges.

At ELA, Jacek is in charge of HR, Finance, Facilities and ICT. He coordinated all of ELA's start-up activities in these areas, including financial autonomy, recruitment, negotiations with the Host State about Headquarters and Sublease agreements, and the setup of the new offices in Bratislava.
